Regular Council Meeting  
Monday, January 23, 2017

With a quorum present, Mayor Eddie Ford called the City of Jenkinsburg's Council meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Attending were Council Members: Mayor Pro-Tem Richard Weaver, Jason Watts, Joye England, Susan Barabas, Kenneth Rooks and City Clerk Clair Jones.

Council Member Jason Watts gave the invocation and Mayor Eddie Ford led the Pledge to the Flag.

Adopt Agenda - A motion was made by Richard Weaver to adopt the agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Kenneth Rooks. Council voted: Richard Weaver - yes, Joye England - yes, Jason Watts – yes, Susan Barabas – yes, Kenneth Rooks - yes. The motion passed.

Approve Minutes - A motion was made by Kenneth Rooks to approve the minutes as presented from the January 9, 2017 meeting. The motion was seconded by Jason Watts. Oath of Office – Attorney Natalie Sundeen was sworn in as the City of Jenkinsburg Municipal Court Judge by Judge William A. Fears.

Old Business: Case # 12(02)2016 - The rezoning of the property located at the corner of Hwy 42 and Burg Rd, (Map E2, Parcel 3) Jenkinsburg, Land Lot 144, First Land District, from AR – Agricultural – Residential to HB – Highway Business. – A motion was made by Jason Watts to approve the rezoning request. The motion was seconded by Kenneth Rooks. After consideration and debate, the Council voted: Kenneth Rooks – yes, Richard Weaver – no, Joye England - no, Jason Watts – yes, Susan Barabas – yes. The motion passed.

A Proclamation Jenkinsburg, GA Arbor Day – February 19, 2017 – Mayor Ford read and signed the Proclamation for Jenkinsburg, GA Arbor Day as February 19, 2017. The city will celebrate by planting a tree on February 17, 2017.

Shannon Lemon – Postmaster Lemon spoke about bringing in additional businesses to Jenkinsburg. She ask the council if they would be opposed to her speaking to business and property owners about building a small plaza on the property of Mr. Cleveland's at Hwy 42 and County Line.

Mayor's Report – No report given.

Public Comments – David Massey, 177 Oak St, Jenkinsburg, spoke to the council regarding the conditions of several properties in the city and requested assistance from the council to address issues he has and has seen around town. He believes these issues are against city ordinances.
